World AIDS Day

On World AIDS Day, December 1, 2024, the Keshav Suri Foundation, in collaboration with the LGBTQ+ Centre and Cipla, hosted the event "Take the Rights Path: My Health, My Right!" at The LaLiT New Delhi to raise awareness about protecting rights to end AIDS and promote health equity.

The event emphasized a rights-based approach to ending AIDS, provided accurate HIV prevention information, and encouraged inclusivity. Key highlights included an expert-led panel discussion with **Dr. Souradipta Chandra, Sahil Chaudhary, and Pranab Barui** on HIV advancements and stigma, an ice-breaking activity to foster engagement, and accessibility through an Indian Sign Language interpreter for the Deaf community.

Free Impulse condoms were distributed to promote safe practices. The Keshav Suri Foundation also honored Dr. Chandra and Cipla representatives for their contributions.

The event successfully raised awareness about health rights, encouraged stigma-free conversations, and provided valuable resources for HIV prevention and health equity, attracting a diverse and engaged audience.
